>> What to bring: Hat, gloves, sturdy footwear, sunscreen, drinking water

Free BBQ and drinks after planting and take a free local native plant to plant at home.

The planting is a continuation of previous planting and will be a combination of local native trees, shrubs and ground covers. This planting will enhance the amenity of the parkland swale area. It will also enhance the habitat values for local flora and fauna and help achieve a Townsville that is Clean and Green.

Everyone is welcome to participate in our Community Greening events. All site preparation (including hole digging) will be done by Council's Greening and Waterway team prior to the event. Activities on the day will include tree planting, fertilising, mulching and watering. Ongoing site maintenance and watering will be a council responsibility.
