



National Tree Day Planting in Your Neighbourhood



Townsville City Council is planning a community tree planting to celebrate National Tree Day 2007. The planting will be part of the Greening Townsville Program and builds on previous community planting to revegetate the drainage area around the park. The planting will be a combination of local native trees and shrubs which will provide shade and enhance the habitat values for local flora and fauna as well as improve amenity.

>> When: Saturday 28 July 2007

>> Where: Macarthur Park, corner of Macarthur Drive & Verbena Court - Annandale (meet near the picnic table)

>> Time: 9am - 12noon

>> What to bring: Hat, gloves, sturdy and enclosed footwear, sunscreen, drinking water

>> Free BBQ and drinks after planting and take a free local native plant to plant at home.

Everyone is welcome to participate in our Community Greening events. All site preparation (including holes digging) will be done by Council's Greening and Waterway team prior to the event. Activities on the day will include tree planting, fertilising, mulching and watering. Ongoing site maintenance and watering will be a council responsibility.
